FROM DUBLIN TO THE UNIQUE BURREN PARK, BLACKLION

Visit the Giant's Grave Wedge Tomb, rolling hills & monuments



Situated about 3km from the village of Blacklion and north-west of the Cuilcagh Mountain you will find this beautiful limestone plateau at a height of approx. 295 metres above sea level.

The park holds a number of magnificent archeological monuments including the Giant's Grave Wedge Tomb and limestone bedrock formed in a shallow tropical sea around 340 million years ago.

There are over 10km of trails whose unique design means a walker has their choice of stunning pathways through the area; all of which bring them back to the Visitor Centre. The Visitor Centre on site details the history of the park and its surrounding geological and archeological treasures. We suggest you take in ALL 5 trails - totaling approx. 10km and taking around 3 hours to complete.

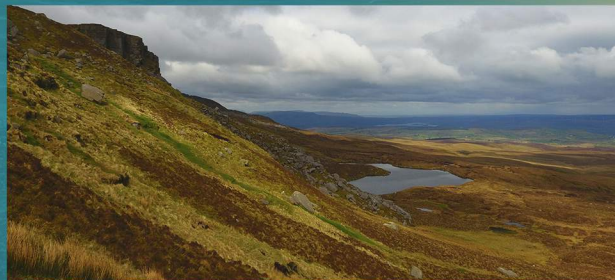

CUILCAGH LEGNABROCKY TRAIL FERMANAGH

Visit an Ancient Cairn 666m above sea level from the Bronze Age!



An exciting walk with consistently stunning views of the Irish landscape. The Stairway To Heaven Tour delivers on its name and is recommended for those seeking adventure and beauty.

The imposing mountain flanks of Cuilcagh give this walk a rich atmosphere and provide breathtaking views. The most impressive is that of Lough Atona: a picturesque lake nestled at the foot of the mountain. It was carved out by a glacier during the last Ice Age approx. 13,000 year ago.

The trail meanders along a quiet farmland track before traversing a wooden boardwalk that consists of a steady climb to the mountain face. From there a stepped boardwalk climbs through the steep terrain and fields of boulders before reaching the summit plateau. A tough mountain path negotiates the wild summit plateau for a few kilometres before reaching the ancient cairn!
